

## Maverick Camporee – Camp Rules

1. All participants must be registered
2. This is not a family camp, this program is for Scouts BSA, Crews and Ships only.
3. Check in with Camporee Staff is required upon arrival.
4. One vehicle per group is allowed at the campsite to unload equipment and materials. This vehicle must be removed from the Friday night by midnight. All vehicles must park backed in, in the parking lot. Equipment trailers are permitted at campsites without tow vehicles.
5. Leaders are responsible to supervise their scouts. Two deep leadership is required at all times.
6. No alcoholic beverages, or drugs as outlined by Boy Scouts of America, are allowed at any time.
7. No firearms allowed.
8. No one may ride on the back of pickup trucks or trailers at any time.
9. Maximum speed is 10 MPH. Speed limit is 5 MPH when passing campsites, activity areas or pedestrians.
10. Quiet time 10:0 pm to 6:00 am.
11. ATV's, OHV's or motorcycles are allowed. (Except Camp Ranger ATV)
12. Pets (dogs, cats, etc.) are not allowed in camp.
13. Any repair needs or damages should be reported to the Ranger before leaving.
14. Emergencies are to be reported to the Medical Officer or Camp Ranger immediately. 911 must be called by Ranger.
15. If fires are permitted, they must be kept in the fire-ring of the campsite. No other fires may be built.
16. Bag and dump your garbage in the dumpster. Check with the Camp Ranger if you don't know where it is.
17. Do not move or relocate the picnic tables or tent platforms.
18. Leave the area better than you found it.
19. Check out with the Camporee Staff is required. Your campsite will be inspected prior to departure.
20. No group may use any Shooting Sports area, Aquatics area or Climbing area
21. We should all be living by the Scout Oath and Law at our Camporee.
